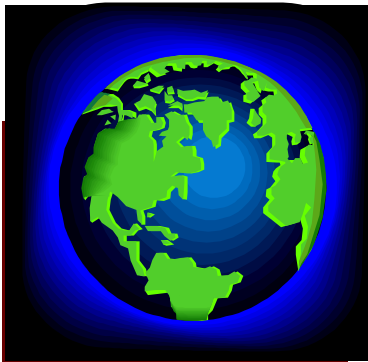


Into All The World!

Thanks again to Him and to you for making all this possible. We have reached over 2000 this quarter in many locations, continuing with our teacher and leadership training classes, and combined gospel preaching campaigns. Here are some of the **highlights:**

Torreon, Mexico—After several years of study with the Aviacion congregation where about 130 attend, they appointed elders Jan. 24th.

Monterrey, Mexico—We began working with the San Bernabe congregation where Pio Escobedo preaches. This is probably the largest in Monterrey with around 170 members. They are also preparing to install elders and deacons. While there, we visited a drug rehab center and studied with some of the inmates. We baptized 12 in one day and a congregation since then has been started at the center itself. Several more have been baptized.

Caracas, Venezuela –As part of a 3-1/2 week trip, we held a week long, combined leadership-preacher training session at three locations simultaneously. We held bible studies with the preachers in the mornings, did some evangelism in the afternoons, and studied with the congregations in the evenings. Paco, Beto and Jonathon helped with the well organized scheduling. We were able to reach over 300 students this way combining the efforts of the 6 local churches. Even though we didn’t really have a gospel meeting, 14 were baptized as a result of the effort. We have already scheduled this same event in two other areas in Venezuela later on in the year.

Cocoli, Venezuela –Venezuela’s bi-annual preacher’s retreat was held there this month. Paco Rada and yours truly were the keynote speakers. It was my second preachers retreat in less than a year. Again, the major success of this effort, besides the encouragement and training was to see a marked improvement in the unity and fellowship accomplished among the 45 preachers that attended. Pedro Fidel Rodriguez, the preacher from the host congregation, did an excellent job in organizing the three day event.

Central and Southern Mexico, Guatemala, Honduras and Nicaragua—Jorge Membreno is our “*Real, in house, authentic old time missionary*” who makes 2 to 3 month trips riding buses, trains, forging rivers, walking, etc. He has been covering all of the above areas since early February. Jorge rarely returns home with less that 30 or 40 baptized during his trips. Jorge suffered a stroke recently, but that hasn’t slowed him down at all.

Chile –In spite of the major earthquake and its dire consequences, their increased efforts with the Vocational Training Program continue steadfastly. Helmer went to Montevideo, Uruguay, Pedro Sanchez to Chillan, and Milton Muñoz to Chiguayante. They are covering 11 locations in Chile as well as helping in Peru, Bolivia and Uruguay.
